BLOOD-BORNE PATHOGEN EXPOSURE CONTROL

Pursuant to the requirements of applicable federal and state law, the superintendent shall issue, by administrative regulation, a blood-borne pathogen exposure control plan. At a minimum, the regulation should require all school district employees and volunteers to observe universal precautions for infectious disease prevention when handling or dealing with body fluids and other potentially infectious materials. The superintendent shall identify those employees most likely to have occupational exposure to infectious diseases and offer the appropriate vaccinations at school district expense.
